Job Title: Nurse Practitioner or Physician Assistant

Position Summary: This position is a mid-level provider with current certification/licensure in the State of Colorado. This position will be responsible to fill the standard expectations of a Advanced Practice Provider in a GI setting, but not limited to direct patient care in both the inpatient and outpatient setting.

Position Accountabilities:

- Manages the health care of a select group of patients as directed by RMG physicians.
- Performs a comprehensive health assessment, including health history, physical exams, preventive screening; identifies medical health risks and needs.
- Formulates the appropriate differential diagnoses based on clinical evaluation.
- Performs, orders and/or interprets diagnostic studies within scope of practice.
- Performs advanced technical procedures within scope of practice.
- Plans and implements therapeutic regimens that include both nursing and medical management strategies, including prescription of medication/devices. Includes obtaining and maintaining prescriptive authority.
- Establishes systematic follow-up for the evaluation of the plan of care and reassesses and modifies the plan as necessary.
- Assures patient and family teaching is adequate to manage the illness or wellness plan at home.
- Participates as a team in providing healthcare, interacting with professional colleagues to provide comprehensive care as a responsible professional.
- Maintains accurate, legible and confidential records and ensures appropriate billing process is followed for all patients.
- Maintains competency and enhances professional growth and development through continuing education, conferences and seminars.
